South Kolkata Nrityangan', a premier dance institution for Bharatanatyam, was established in November 2005. Nrityangan was conceived by eminent Bharatanatyam dancer Jhinook Mukherjee Sinha with the aim to re-establish the fading glory of Indian classical dance today. She believes that by spreading the vast knowledge and rich values of Indian arts and culture to young children, we will succeed in making them experience and preserve our opulent heritage.



The focus of the institution is to offer an equal opportunity to all age groups and financial backgrounds. The students' age vary from 4 year old blooming buds to older, married women. The institution has students from myriad backgrounds. We offer poor children, even those who belong to the slums, an opportunity to learn the art of dance and make dancing their profession, together with the mainstream students.




South Kolkata Nrityangan is also associated with an orphanage named 'Refugee' and the institution routinely aids the teachers and children of the NGO.
